MUSIC FESTIVAL IN THE PARK ENTRY POLICY

To provide a safer environment for the public and significantly expedite patron entry into the *Music Festival in the Park*, this policy has been implemented. THIS POLICY IS SUBJECT TO CHANGE WITHOUT NOTICE. Full Terms and Conditions can be found at: www.dallaspride.org/festival

Dallas Pride strongly encourages attendees to not bring any type of bag or container, which allows for faster entry through the “No Bag” lane at the entrance. If you do bring a bag or container, you’ll be subject to search in the other lines by contracted private security personnel.

Patrons arriving with a bag or container that is not permissible will be denied entry. Dallas Pride does not accept any liability for unattended, lost, or stolen items. Each individual person accepts and assumes full responsibility and liability for their unattended, lost, or stolen items.

1. Allowed & Prohibited Items

ALLOWED

- Bags that do not exceed 18”x18”
- Binoculars
- Blankets, sheets and towels
- Strollers
- Cameras
- Portable/collapsible chair
- Sunscreen
- Bug repellent
- Prescribed medication
- Coolers or containers used only for medical purposes or child and infant food and beverages
- Diaper bags and similar items required for infants or children
- Service Animal as defined under the American with Disabilities Act as a dog that has been individually trained to do work or perform tasks for an individual with a disability

PROHIBITED

- Bags that exceed 18”x18”
- Drones or any other remote flying device
- Glass containers of any kind
- Firearms, explosives, or weapons of any kind
- Illegal and Illicit substances of any kind
- Illegal drugs or drug paraphernalia
- Alcoholic beverages of any kind
- Water bottles or hydration packs. Water is available for purchase.
- Pets (including emotional support or therapy animals, except service animals)
- Emotional support or therapy animal not defined under Title II or Title III of the Americans with Disabilities Act and Texas Human Resources Code Title 8, Chapter 121

2. Security Screening and Entry

For the safety of festival attendees, all patrons are subject to a security screening prior to entry.

Screening of children will always take place with the consent of a parent or guardian. Families are encouraged to use the dedicated Family Entrance, which is tailored to children and families

All bags and containers will be searched before entry. To speed up entry, leave your bags at home, and take advantage of No Bag lanes.

Please contact Festival Staff located at the entrance with any questions or to ask for assistance.

3. Re-Entry

Patrons will be security screened upon re-entry to the festival. Bags and containers will be searched as well. A purchased and unbroken wristband must be worn on the wrist for re-entry to the festival.

4. Children Attending Dallas Pride

The Family Pride Zone, located in its own secure area, caters exclusively to children up to the age of 12 and all kids are welcome! A dedicated Family Entrance is available next to the main Festival entrance. Children 12 years and younger will be admitted free of charge.
