FESTIVAL RULES

1. General

- 1.1 Each Vendor must agree to all the rules herein and are responsible for informing all vendor affiliates of these rules.
- 1.2 The deadline for applications will cease on May 4th, 2020, we will accept no additional applications. **There will be NO exceptions to this rule. Additional wristbands, tables, and chairs may still be purchased beyond this date in the application system.**
- 1.3 All of the applicant's contact information must be complete. Incorrect contact information may delay or prevent the processing of the application. Once the application is approved, you will receive confirmation by phone or e-mail that you are a Vendor.
- 1.4 Vendor Booth placement is assigned at the sole discretion of the Festival Committee. The application must be **PAID by May 4th, 2020** to be included in the Festival.
- 1.5 If two or more Vendors would like to be placed together, they must contact the Festival Committee. All reasonable attempts will be made to accommodate such requests but are not guaranteed. Each Vendor must still have an individual contact. Each application must have separate fees.
- 1.6 **You will pick up your Vendor Packets on Friday, June 5th, 2020, during vendor set-up.**
- 1.7 As it is impossible to anticipate every situation that may arise, no conduct that violates any statute of the State of Texas or any ordinance on the City of Dallas will be tolerated. Any Vendor violating applicable law will be prohibited from participating at the Festival and will be removed from the Festival.

2. Vendor Booth Set-up

- 2.1 Vendors will have access to vendor specific parking with parking pass. **You will NOT be charged for parking during set up on Friday, June 5th, 2020. First Come first Served.**



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- 2.2 No Vendors will be allowed to set-up after Saturday, June 6th, 2020 at 10:45 AM.
- 2.3 Each Vendor booth is 10'x10' and does not extend past those dimensions unless additional booth space has been purchased. Any signage or other objects placed outside of the booth must not intrude on neighboring booths.
- 2.4 Vendors are responsible for their own tables, chairs, fans, extension cords, shade/tent, food/drink. Tables and chairs will be available for rent during set-up and from the application system leading up to the event.
- 2.5 Outside Vendors with tents must have them secured.
Sandbags and weights of any kind will not be provided by Dallas Pride.
- 2.6 Each 10'x10' Vendor booth will include, one (1) parking pass, two (2) vendor wristbands, WIFI (*currently excluding Teen Pride and Family Pride Zone*), 3' Pipe and Drape, and a standard 20amp 3 prong outlet. **Generators are NOT allowed.** Please make arrangements ASAP for further power needs.
- 2.7 Vendors are encouraged to display their identity through a variety of visual media such as signs, banners, balloons, flags and/or t-shirts.
- 2.8 Booth spaces are assigned to comply with safety requirements and City of Dallas ordinances. An organization shall not relocate to a different area.
- 2.9 Recommendations for rental companies will not be provided.
- 2.10 A Vendor that utilizes a rental company for its booth must coordinate with and be present to meet with the rental company. Rental companies will be turned away if the Vendor is not present.
- 2.11 We require that all Vendors remain at the Festival until 8:00 PM. Early departures may encourage attendees to leave early if Vendor spaces are vacant.
- 2.12 Please make sure all trash and Items have been removed from your Vendor Booth after your load out is complete.
- 3.1 Open flames. This includes but is not limited to fuel or charcoal grills of any type; camping stoves (i.e. Coleman stoves); and any other flame producing device or equipment. Items such as cigarette lighters and matches are excluded.
- 3.2 Staking of any kind. This includes tent stakes.
- 3.3 Parking on the grass or driving through any portion of the Festival area unless permission has been given by the Festival Committee.
- 3.4 Glass Containers.
- 3.5 Securing or hanging anything from the trees, shrubs, and lamps located throughout Fair Park.
- 3.6 Distribution of alcoholic products of any type.
- 3.7 Selling food or beverage items is prohibited. Only approved food vendor applicants may sell food or beverage products. **Candy is permitted. Food and beverage for personal use is acceptable.**

4. Dress and Behavior

- 4.1 The Festival Committee encourages all participants to appear in appropriate attire and engage in conduct that celebrates true LGBT Pride. The goal of the Festival Committee and Dallas Pride is to promote not only the pride, but also the unity and appreciation of diversity. Dress or conduct displayed by any Vendor contrary to this ideal or that is intentionally demeaning to any other group will not be tolerated. No exceptions to this rule.
- 4.2 Dallas Pride encourages all Vendors to show respect for all genders, ages, races, cultures, lifestyles, faiths and sexual orientations. All participants are asked to display an attitude that promotes pride in the LGBT community. Vendors may not show improper conduct toward any other group or individual.
- 4.3 In the event that any individual attendee or group of protestors heckles any individual or Vendor represented at the Festival, Vendors are encouraged to ignore the situation and NOT respond to the protestors.



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- 4.4 In accordance with the City of Dallas public nudity ordinance, Vendors must not expose genitalia, buttocks, or female breasts.

5. Extreme Weather Policy

- 5.1 In the event of extreme weather, including but not limited to rain, Dallas Pride reserves the right to cancel the Festival. All reasonable options will be sought to ensure the Festival continues. However, the safety of all attendees is our first concern.
- 5.2 In the event of a cancellation, Festival fees will not be refunded in whole or part.

6. Rule Enforcement

- 6.1 The above rules and regulations are subject to the interpretation of the Festival Committee and will be enforced by Dallas Pride. These rules are created, not to inhibit your celebration in anyway, but rather to protect and enhance both the experience of the Vendor and attendee.
- 6.2 Dallas Pride and Festival Committee retains the right to assess additional repair or clean-up costs to any Vendor causing damage, generating excessive litter or abandoning refuse.

These rules are subject to change. Any and all reasonable attempts will be made to notify festival participants of any changes.
